PRE-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS AND REMINDERS

We would like to make this experience as smooth as possible for you. Therefore, this is a friendly reminder about some important instructions before and after surgery. Please contact us with any questions.

BEFORE SURGERY:

- 1. Be sure to pick up your Rx before surgery and have it available the day of surgery.
- 2. Reduce sodium 2 weeks before surgery and do not take any blood thinning medications.
- 3. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING after PM / AM the night before / the day of your surgery.
- 4. Please refrain from caffeine 48 hours before surgery.
- 5. Wash your face with anti-bacterial soap (see your "Shopping List" for suggestions) the morning of surgery. Do not apply anything to your face after washing.
- 6. Wash your hair the morning of surgery. Do not apply hair products after shampoo / conditioner. (ie: gel, spray, mousse, etc)
- 7. Wear a top that buttons up or zips, to avoid anything going over the head (nothing fancy, you may get blood on it after surgery)
- 8. Wear bottoms / pants that are casual, comfy, and not tight (no skinny jeans, yoga pants, or leggings)....sweats or PJ's are fine
- 9. Shoes must have a back on them....tennis shoes are great. No tall Ugg boots, flip flops, or slip-ons
- 10. Stay well hydrated, and drink plenty of water the night before surgery.
- 11. Typically, the anesthesiologist and a nurse from the surgery center will contact you. In the rare event that they cannot reach you, you can contact the surgery center directly.

DAY OF SURGERY:

- 1. Please arrive 1.5 hours for SFSC **or** 1 hour for GBSC before your scheduled surgery time.
- 2. Your anesthesia and facility fees are due prior to your surgery. Please bring a cashier's check for the exact amount or you can pay with a major credit card. (see below)
- 3. Methods of Payment for Surgery Centers:
 - The San Francisco Surgery Center Cash EXACT Amount, Cashier's Check EXACT Amount, Visa, and MasterCard.
 - The Greenbrae Surgery Center EXACT Cash, Cashier's Check, Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover
- 4. Remember, it is possible that OR time for your case may go over the proposed amount. In that case, overage charges for both the facility and anesthesiologist will be charged.
- 5. If you wear Contacts / Glasses bring a case & solution with you.
- 6. If you use an inhaler (either regularly or rescue only) Please bring it with you to the surgery center.
- 7. When travelling significant distance home from the surgery center, you may want to pack: pillow, water, crackers, hat (no glasses), nausea bag / bin. Also mention this to the intake Nurse AND Anesthesiologist for anti-nausea medications.
- 8. You can arrive at the surgery center by any method you prefer. However, you cannot take a cab home or to your hotel after surgery. You must have a family member or friend transport you. If you do not have anyone to transport you after surgery, we can assist you with recommendations for a medical transport service to take you to your home or to your hotel after surgery.
- 9. You must have a family member or friend with you for 24 hours after surgery. If you need a resource for aftercare help, please let us know well in advance of your surgery date.

AFTER SURGERY:

- 1. The prescribed full course of ANTIBIOTICS MUST BE COMPLETED. Failure to finish your prescribed antibiotics may result in an infection, and could negatively affect your surgery results.
- 2. Icing only AROUND the nasal area for Rhinoplasty (do not put ANYTHING on top of your cast / nose for 6 weeks after surgery. The first 10 days are the only days icing helps.
- 3. NO glasses or sunglasses for 4-6 weeks after Rhinoplasty surgery. You must tape them to your forehead if you need to utilize them (check the internet for utube video instructions).
- 4. No exercising for 3 weeks after surgery. You may exercise on the 22nd day after your surgery dates.
- 5. No plane rides for 7 10 days after your surgery date.
