According to Dr. Kim, "gone are the days when surgeons can give every patient the same cookie-cutter nose. With an expanding cosmetic market, we must now cater to cosmetic needs based on a variety of ethnic and familial preferences."

Dr. Kim will bring this global perspective to the Dubai Rhinoplasty Symposium. Along with his US expert compatriots, Dr. Kim has shaped the Symposium with the guidance of an international team of plastic surgery leaders from Iran, U.A.E., Saudi Arabia, Egypt, and Turkey.
